After receipt of the completed application form, Mindbody Wellness will check to ensure you meet the eligibility criteria and may get in touch to request further information.

Once offered a place on the course, you will need to secure your place by paying the non-refundable £220 deposit, which includes the registration and e-learning fees for the Awarding Organisation British Wheel of Yoga Qualifications (BWYQ).

All sessions will be recorded; if you cannot attend a specific date, you will be able to view the recording/submit the work so that you meet the minimum of 80% attendance. There will be other one-off sessions on Zoom to be arranged with the tutor in between or after the course dates.

Assessed Class Teaching (ACT) takes place after the Online Practical Zoom Course Dates with Tutor, when you have set up your specialist 4-6 week yoga course for mums and babies. The Assessor will come to observe and assess your skills for attainment of the BWYQ Level 3 Technical Specialist in Adapting and Developing Postnatal Yoga for Mums and Babies qualification.

This is the final assessment for the qualification that provides evidence of your competence in meeting the occupational standards set by employers, as approved by IfATE/Skills England and the Department for Education.
